This Agreement is made _____ (today's date) between Jontelle Forbus of Equine Associates, LLC (herein referred to EALLC), located at Chestnut Oak Stable, Inc, 29222 Signboard Road Ruther Glen, Virginia 22546, to serve as training premises, and _____ (owner of horse).

This Agreement is made between EALLC, who will provide board and training services and act as Agent for Owner, and Owner _____ residing at _____ (mailing address) _____ Phone number. Owner warrants that he/she owns horse(s) and will provide, prior to time of delivery, proof of negative Coggins test and record of immunizations. Owner agrees to sign applicable Waiver and Release forms for both EALLC and Chestnut Oak Stables, Inc. before riding or handling horses on premises.

1) FEES

Equine Associates and Chestnut Oak and Employees are devoted to top-notch horse care. Board, including (but not limited to); stabling, feeding up to 4x/day, mucking, turnout and night check is provided by EALLC at the rate of \$800/month.

Training includes five/days/week at the rate of \$1000/month. Private lessons can be arranged upon prior organization with Jontelle Forbus. A 30 day written notice is required prior to leaving the EALLC training/board program. Written notices can be given to: Jontelle Forbus. Written notices are not applicable in the case of sales horses.

Grooming services are provided by EALLC at the rate of \$200 month. Grooming includes: basic grooming supplies (shampoo, Show Sheen, hoof oil, laundry soap, Vetrolin), grooming and tacking up for trainer, tack cleaning, picking out feet after turnout, checking for injury, bandaging legs as needed, changing coolers, holding for farrier or veterinarian. Clients are responsible for grooming for their lessons.

Should said equine be sold while in training with EALLC/Jontelle Forbus, commission should be agreed upon prior to the sale of the horse.

3) TURNOUT

For the safety of consideration of staff and horses in the care of EALLC, we require a leather lead with a chain shank and a leather halter or nylon halter with a leather headstall. Amount of turnout will be determined according to management with consideration of the riding schedule, pasture and weather conditions. Horses are turned out individually or the option of group turnout (if all horses are compatible) exists.

4) EXPRESS ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

While this horse is in training with EALLC, all reasonable efforts will be made to ensure the safety, proper care and wellbeing of your Horse. Owner agrees to sign the EXPRESS ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT.

5) ROUTINE AND EMERGENCY CARE

If medical treatment is needed, EALLC will attempt to call the Owner, but in the event the Owner can not be reached, Chestnut Oak Stables, Inc./EALLC, has the authority to secure

veterinary and/or farrier care. Owner is responsible to pay all costs relating to this care. EALLC is authorized as Owner's agent to arrange billing to the Owner. EALLC agrees to implement a shoeing programs consistent with recognized standards. Owner is obligated to pay the expenses of such services.

Either party may terminate this Agreement. Owner agrees to give EALLC, thirty days advance upon termination of this Agreement.

7) RIGHT OF LIEN

EALLC, has the Right of Lien as set forth in the Law of the State of Virginia for the amount due for training and additional agreed upon services and shall have the right, without process of law to retain said horse(s) until indebtedness is satisfactorily paid in full.
